

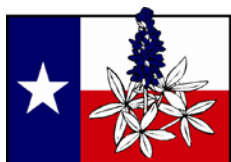

In July, 1933 Charles Urschel, a wealthy Oklahoma oilman, was kidnapped from his home by Machine Gun Kelley and Albert Bates. Blindfolded and gagged he was driven to a remote, rundown farmhouse near Paradise, Texas where he was chained and guarded by two members of the Shannon family.
